DEAR SISTERS AND BROTHERS IN CHRIST,

One of our Lenten observances is Maundy Thursday. Maundy is the English form of the Latin word meaning commandment. Jesus' new commandment to "love one another even as I have loved you" is the focus of Maundy Thursday. This love is demonstrated in Jesus' example of servanthood and the gift of Jesus' self in Holy Communion. Many churches follow the Maundy Thursday service of the table with the Order of Tenebrae. Tenebrae is the Latin term of shadows. It is a service of lessons accompanied by the gradual extinquishing of lights. The readings commemorate the last days before Christ's burial.



It's been many years since we gathered in the Fellowship Hall for these commemorations, so we will do it this year. Thursday, March 28, starting at 5:30 pm we will gather in the Fellowship Hall (L room) for a light supper of soup and finger foods. We will commemorate the Last Supper and Tenebrae together. Starting early, we hope to end our gathering before night fall, for all of those who aren't fond of driving at night. We will need a "head" count in order to have enough food. Fast from selfishness and be compassionate.


Fast from grudges and be reconciled.
