Clean Up Bucket Day Please Help Us!!

Clean Up Bucket day will be Thursday, September 21, at St. John UCC in Collinsville 307 W. Clay St., Collinsville IL 62234 Drop off the specific items for the buckets by 9 am Assembly of buckets begins at 10 am.

Bring completed buckets between 10 am and 2 pm.

Before Sept. 18th - Please let Priscilla know if, what, and how many buckets or items you/your c

hurch will provide. This is important so the transporter will know what size truck to bring. We will be communicating that information with them on Sept. 18.

Volunteers will be needed to help with assembly and loading the truck on September 21.

Arrangements have been made with Stock Transport to have a truck there for us to load and they will transport them to the Corpus Christi/Houston area - exact location to be determined yet. There are three UCC churches that are accepting the clean-up buckets and hygiene kits to be distributed. Priscilla will contact them to see where the most need is at that time.

CWS Emergency Cleanup Buckets

Supplies needed:

One five-gallon bucket with resealable lid (If bucket has been used, clean well but do not use if it has held chemicals of any kind.) Four scouring pads Seven sponges, including one large One scrub brush Eighteen reusable cleaning towels (e.g. Easy Wipes) One 50 oz. or two 25 oz. bottle(s) of liquid laundry detergent One 16-28 oz. bottle of liquid disinfectant dish soap One 12-16 oz. bottle of household cleaner that can be mixed with water (no spray bottles) One package of 48-50 clothespins Clothesline, two 50 ft. or one 100 ft. Five dust masks Two pairs non surgical latex gloves One pair work gloves, cotton with leather palm or all leather 24-28 heavy duty or contractor type 30-45 gallon trash bags on a roll and removed from carton One 6-9 oz. bottle of non-aerosol insect repellent

All cleaning items must be new— all liquid items must be capped and securely tightened. Place all items into the bucket, making sure they are packed securely to avoid damage during shipment. Snap the lid on tight and seal with packing tape.
