# **SCRIPTURE LESSON: Acts 16:9-15**

<sup>9</sup> A vision of a man from Macedonia came to Paul during the night. He stood urging Paul, "Come over to Macedonia and help us!" <sup>10</sup> Immediately after he saw the vision, we prepared to leave for the province of Macedonia, concluding that God had called us to proclaim the good news to them.

Lydia's conversion

<sup>11</sup> We sailed from Troas straight for Samothrace and came to Neapolis the following day. <sup>12</sup> From there we went to Philippi, a city of Macedonia's first district and a Roman colony. We stayed in that city several days. <sup>13</sup> On the Sabbath we went outside the city gate to the riverbank, where we thought there might be a place for prayer. We sat down and began to talk with the women who had gathered. <sup>14</sup> One of those women was Lydia, a Gentile God-worshipper from the city of Thyatira, a dealer in purple cloth. As she listened, the Lord enabled

her to embrace Paul's message. <sup>15</sup> Once she and her household were baptized, she urged, "Now that you have decided that I am a believer in the Lord, come and stay in my house." And she persuaded us.

#### \*GOSPEL: John 14:22-29

<sup>22</sup> Judas (not Judas Iscariot) asked, "Lord, why are you about to reveal yourself to us and not to the world?"
<sup>23</sup> Jesus answered, "Whoever loves me will keep my word. My Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them. <sup>24</sup> Whoever doesn't love me doesn't keep my words. The word that you hear isn't mine. It is the word of the Father who sent me.

<sup>25</sup> "I have spoken these things to you while I am with

you. <sup>26</sup> The Companion, <sup>[a]</sup> the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and will remind you of everything I told you. <sup>27</sup> "Peace I leave with you. My peace I give you. I give to you not as the world gives. Don't be troubled or afraid. <sup>28</sup> You have heard me tell you, 'I'm going away and returning to you.' If you loved me, you would be happy that I am going to the Father, because the Father is greater than me. <sup>29</sup> I have told you before it happens so that when it happens you will believe.

# **MESSAGE: "Recipe for Peace"**

Let's pretend that you received an invitation to be a contestant on the Great British Bake Off on television. The show invites amateur bakers to compete with others on how they bake cakes, cookies, biscuits, and delicious desserts. Only those who have not gone to official "cooking school" are invited to compete. So where have these contestants learned to bake. Most of the learned from their mothers, grandmothers, aunts, or maybe their family owned a bakery and they watched as children.

My favorite challenge that these contestants are asked to bake involve the judges giving the contestants only a partial recipe. None of them have the full recipe to bake the same dish. The recipe might be missing, how long to bake it, what temperature, how long to knead the dough or let it rest, or some other important part of the recipe to make the results perfect.

So, how are they going to manage this? Well, perhaps they have made the dessert before or at least tried a full recipe some other time and they recall the details. Or maybe they learned to bake from watching their mothers, grandmothers, aunts, etc. Or maybe they guess from their experience baking something else. In our gospel lesson the "good" Judas asks Jesus a similar question. He says, "Master, how will it be that you will

show yourself to us and not to the world?" At this stage of their listening to Jesus, the disciples still don't have all that they need to spread the good news. Jesus has a vision, but the disciples have only a partial view of this recipe for peace and love.

This part of the Gospel of John, from 14:22-31, is practically the whole "cook-book" for the disciples and us to follow to bring in the kingdom of God. However, it is not complete, just as the partial recipe to the contestants in the baking contest.

Jesus says, "if you love me, keep my word." He says, "I'm giving you my own peace which is different than the world gives. Don't be troubled or fearful." "Be glad that I'm going to my father who is greater than I." "All this is happening so that the world may know that I love the father, and that I'm doing what the father has told me to do." God the father is acting like the mother, grandmother, or aunt, who teaches others how to bake perfect bread.

Jesus' "cook-book" has an addendum, some tips to make you the best evangelist you can be. A helper called the Holy Spirit; the one the father will send in Jesus' name. The Holy Spirit will teach you everything and bring back to your mind everything Jesus has said to you.

The next chapter of the Gospel of John gives us more important lessons from Jesus including an image of the "true vine." I invite you to read on.

In the meantime, good baking and remember that Jesus is the bread of life. There's no such thing as over baked or under needed. Let it rise! Amen.
