

Dear Brothers and Sisters of faith,

The saying goes, "if you don't like the weather in the Midwest, just wait a few hours because it will change." Another thing that changes is the Covid virus. Just when we think we are on "the other side" of this pandemic, variants pop-up and people are getting sick again.

Please know that your Church Council is paying attention to all of these changes and the Illinois Department of Public Health recommendations. Evidently if you have had a conversation for 15 minutes with someone who tested positive, you should get tested after 5 days of that conversation and try to isolate yourself in the meantime. If you test positive, you should quarantine yourself for 10 days and then get retested. If you are indoors with a crowd of people, wear your masks. Or if you are just not sure, wear them anyway. There's no shame in that.

What about at church? I think we need to go back to having the ushers dismiss us starting with those in the back. We ask that you go on outside and have conversations with others out there so we don't "bunch up" in the narthex. Usually we sit far enough apart and you are welcome to wear a mask anytime. Hopefully taking those small measures will keep us safe.

"CALLING ALL MEMBERS AND PARISHIONERS"

Recently your Church Council had been concerned about notifying everyone quickly. Judy sends out blast emails, but what about those without computers? So they are looking into a "one call" system like they have a school. Here's more information from Sharon who has been working on this project.

"New Way to Communicate with Church Members"

A software package called Call Multiplier will be used to help church staff contact members of the congregation by phone message or text message. The Church Council has been looking for ways to reach members who do not have Internet access. We have decided to try a software package called, Call Multiplier. This software will allow a voice message to be sent to your home or cell phone or a text message to your cell phone. Judy will be contacting each person to see whether you would prefer a voice message be sent to your home phone or cell phone or a text message to your cell phone.

The text message phone number you will see when a message is sent from the church is (618) 226-5798. The text message will start with the church's name "St. John UCC".
