It may be one about which everyone will know and which history will remember, or it may be one about which no one will ever hear; but in either case, it is a task for God."

Paul's God-given task was to evangelize a world; to most of us, it will simply be to make one or two people happy in the little circle of those most dear to us. God sends every individual into the world with a part to play in his purpose. No task is too large or too small.
