Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

"According to Wikipedia, Lent is a Christian tradition that is observed in many denominations. It is the hallowed forty-day period of sacrifice leading up to Jesus' death and Resurrection. During Lent, Orthodox Christians, Catholics and some Protestants prepare for Holy Week by fasting, praying, and reconciling with the Lord. These forty days are a wonderful time to rethink everything and to allow ourselves to take up our crosses as Christ once did. It's a season of solemnity and sacrifice commemorating Jesus' exodus into the desert; our sacrifice is a reminder of the sacrifice of self Jesus made to save us from our sins. Because of this, it is a Lenten tradition to sacrifice something for these 40 days." Lent is a time to get closer to God.

However, as we learned in our Gospel message last Sunday, Christians DO things not just give up things. So, here's a few things I thought someone could do. Clean out a closet and donate the clothes to a charity. Clean kitchen cabinets and donate what you don't use. Check your bookshelves. If you never plan to read a book or read it again, donate them to the Memorial Hospital Book sale. Right now, there are bins for your book donations inside the doors of both hospitals, and all their medical offices. Clean the inside of your car and clean your neighbor's car also. After your garbage truck has been through your neighborhood, walk the empty bins back to their places for all your neighbors. Call church members you haven't seen lately. Send cards to all the shut-ins. Maybe you can think of some more.

I ordered some devotionals to offer you. I'll put them in the narthex when I receive them. And speaking of devotions, beginning on March 16 I will offer a Lenten study. It will be through Zoom and start at 6:30 pm the last three Wednesdays in March and the first Wednesday in April. We will share some readings, discuss them, and have a time for prayer. If you don't have a computer, you can call in. We will be able to hear each other but not see each other. The Zoom meeting ID is 878-8123-0951 and the pass code is 651278.
